Week 1 Weather	Talk about words that begin with the letter Yy.	Count how many clouds you see. Do any of them resemble familiar objects or animals?	Read books together about Weather. If you don't have any, look up pictures and videos online.	Discuss the different properties of water with your child. Show them the difference between boiling water and ice.	Act out various types of weather with your body (ex: waving your arms for wind, spinning for tornados, etc).
Week 2 Fables	Line up toys on the edge of the bathtub while taking a bath in order from big to small. Count them together.	Read some fables together. If you don't have any books of fables, you can find the stories online.	Talk about words that begin with the letter Zz.	Use stuffed animals to tell the story of "The Tortoise and the Hare."	Hold two objects above your head. Ask your child to predict which one will fall faster. Test their
Week 3 Fairy Tales	Read your favorite fairy tale together.	Play a game of Under/Over. Ask your child what goes under or over different objects. Ex. Feet under table, bodies over chair; etc predictions.	Dance to your favorite theme song together.	Collect various rocks around the yard together. Help your child sort into groups of small and large.	Sing the alphabet song together. Ask your child to find objects around the house that begin with each letter of the alphabet.
Week 4 Nursery Rhymes	Find different shapes around the house. Talk about their differences.	Sing nursery rhymes together. Ex. Row, Row, Row Your boat; Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star; Hickory Dickory, Dock; etc	Find different objects around the house that rhyme.	Go to the library and pick out a Mother Goose book.	Spell your child's name to them. Help them find the letters to their name around the house.
