Compare ice water to room temperature. | Look for pictures of different kinds of planes and talk about them. |
| <b>Week 3</b><br><b>Community Helpers</b>           | Talk about your job and how your job helps the community.                            | Play a game of Memory together.   | Have your child retell a story to you. Ask about the beginning, middle and end. | Talk about community helpers who help people in need.                                   | Have your child match socks when you do laundry.                    |
