	Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday
Week 1 Dr. Seuss	Read your favorite Dr. Seuss book with your child.	During bath time, rhyme simple words (cat, hat, bat, sat etc)	Walk around the house with your baby and point out objects that are blue.	If your child is able to, allow them to explore play dough.	Measure your little one's height and make it a monthly event.
Week 2 The Zoo	Roar like lions.	Read a book together about Zoo animals.	Sing the song "Five Little Monkeys" while counting on your fingers.	Draw ovals on your child's hands. Talk about what it feels like.	Take time to visit the animals at the zoo.
Week 3 San Diego Wildlife	Stand outside after the sun goes down and listen carefully for local wildlife.	Cook spaghetti noodles in blue water. After cooling, allow your child to explore.	Go on a family nature walk. Point out any animals that you may see.	Find items around the house with different textures and allow your child to explore.	With guidance, allow your child to scribble with a blue marker or crayon.
Week 4 Pets	Have your child practice petting their stuffed animals with gentle hands.	Tell your child a story about a family pet you had while growing up.	Give your child two toys of different weights. Describe their differences.	Practice making animal sounds (meow, woof, squeak, etc).	Go to your local pet store and observe the animals for sale/adoption.
Week 5 Spring	Find books at the library about Spring, cuddle in a cozy corner & read together.	Sing the ABC song together.	Smell the many flowers at the super market. Which one is your favorite?	When you change your child's diaper, count their toes on each foot.	Freeze ice cubes with blue food coloring. Allow your baby to play with them.
